Noosa hinterland bridges replacement program – Tablelands Road Bridge B, Cooran

Work to replace the existing Tablelands Road Bridge B in Cooran is starting this month and will be completed by the end of the year, weather permitting.

Traffic impacts

For the duration of construction, the bridge will be an active work site, so access to the area will be restricted to resident and construction vehicles only.

Residents can expect increased construction traffic and heavy vehicles using Tablelands Road to access the construction site.

Council and the construction contractor, SGQ, have been working with directly impacted residents and Emergency Services to make

sure access can be provided day to day and in the event of an emergency.

Work hours

Construction hours will generally be Monday to Friday, between 7am and 5pm.

Other impacts

With part of Tablelands Road restricted to local traffic only, the following will also be closed:

- James M McKane Memorial Lookout
- Trail 3 - James M McKane lookout, Cooran to Kin Kin via Woondum Forest Reserve.

The project is a joint initiative of Noosa Council and the Australian Government.
