

### Noosa hinterland bridges replacement program – Tablelands Road Bridge B, Cooran and Wahpunga Lane Bridge, Kin Kin

#### Project update

Noosa Council has awarded SGQ Pty Ltd (SGQ) the contract to construct the new Tablelands Road Bridge B at Cooran and the Wahpunga Lane Bridge at Kin Kin.

SGQ has a proven history of bridge construction in the Noosa Shire having previously constructed the Orealla Crescent Bridge over David Low Way at Sunrise Beach.

Features of the two bridges include:

- replacing the single-lane timber bridges with wider single-lane concrete structures
- compliant with current standards
- design lifespan of 100 years.

These new bridges will secure essential connectivity for our Hinterland communities, as well as improving the safety and access for residents and visitors.

Keeping the community informed remains a high priority, and SGQ and Council will be in contact with residents in the coming weeks.

The replacement of these two bridges is part of a joint initiative between Noosa Council and the Federal Government to replace five bridges over the next two years as part of the Bridge Renewal Program.

#### Project timeframe

The procurement process was extended due to additional investigations to resolve issues including scouring at the Wahpunga Lane bridge, site access at Tablelands Road Bridge and COVID-related material delays.

The project delivery schedule is illustrated below. This is subject to weather and construction conditions.
