Cooroy, Musa Vale Road – flood reconstruction

Project summary

Designs and tender documentation is being prepared for the reconstruction of the road edge on the single lane section of Musa Vale Road, Cooroy.

This section of road was damaged during a landslip caused by the major flooding event in February/March 2022.

The geotechnical engineering survey, site survey, initial design and an environmental survey required to complete the final design has been received.

However, the environmental survey shows several sections contain environmentally significant flora, which will require the development of an alternative design to avoid flora. These changes will impact the project cost and extend the delivery schedule.

Scope of Works

The next steps of the project include:

- design revision
- design concept submission for QRA funding approval
- final design development
- invitation to tender
- reconstruction of road asset.

Timing

An update on the planned construction date will be provided when more definite information is available after the development of the final design.

Community Impact

Council acknowledges the community submission made by residents on 14 November 2022. We appreciate your input and will continue to keep in contact with you about:

- progress of the design and the likely timing plan
- construction phase details including road closures.

Council is committed to keeping the community informed and will organise a site visit in coming weeks to discuss these aspects with interested residents.
