Construction Complete – Weyba Esplanade, Noosa Heads

Project summary

Noosa Shire was significantly affected in the 2022 rainfall and flooding event. Council continues the reconstruction efforts to reconstruct damaged areas, this includes Weyba Esplanade along the river edge. This reconstruction work has now been completed and the road is now open.

Overview of works

The scope of works included:

- Demolition and removal of pavement, collapsed kerb structure, and failed material.
- Massbloc, or approved equivalent, wall on concrete foundation
- Pavement reconstruction
- Kerb replacement
- Embankment reconstruction and suitable planting

The flood recovery effort for Noosa Council is jointly funded by the Commonwealth-State Disaster Recovery Funding Arrangements.
