# Noosa Pathways Renewal Works - June/July 2024

#### **Project summary**

Noosa Council is currently implementing multiple pathway upgrades throughout the Noosa Shire as part of its pathway renewals program. Since February, contractors have successfully completed renewal works at seven sites, with an additional six scheduled for completion in the coming months. In total, thirteen sites across the Noosa Shire are scheduled for renewal by July 2024.

Noosa Council's Pathways Renewal Program recognises and prioritises improvements to our existing pathways, creating a connected and safe network designed to get more people riding a bike and walking.

This program follows the successful completion of pathway projects in late 2023 in Cooroy, Pomona and Noosa Heads.

## Timing and community impact

Construction of the next six pathways is scheduled in June/July 2024 with each pathway to take approximately two to three weeks to complete:

- Ferris Park, Sunshine Beach
- Cooroora Creek Park, Pomona
- Armitage Court, Noosaville
- Queen Street, Cooran
- Main Street, Kin Kin
- Elm Street, Cooroy

Traffic control will be in place where required.
