

Noosa Waters Entry Statement Renewal

Project summary

The Noosa Waters Entry Statement is currently in a state of disrepair and in desperate need of renewal. Council will soon commence construction works to revitalize this feature.

To ensure a high-quality renovation, Council has contracted Disc Landscaping, an experienced landscape construction company, to undertake this work.

Design

The design of the planned upgrade work has been developed by Council in close consultation with the Noosa Waters Residents Association (NWRA).

The project aims to enhance the visual appeal of the park by constructing two central crazy-paved blade walls and improving the surrounding landscaping to give the entry statement a fresh and updated look.

The project scope includes:

- Demolition of the existing concrete water feature and ponds.
- Removal of pandanus trees.
- Construction of two-tiered masonry blade walls, faced with crazy paving.
- Installation of a 'Noosa Waters' sign to match the existing entry signage in Noosa Waters.
- Retention of some existing trees to maintain a screen for houses behind the entry statement.
- Turfing the area where the concrete ponds were removed.
- Landscaping the entire mound with native plants and trees.

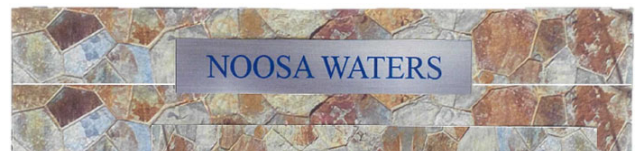


IMAGE: Indicative new blade wall to be surrounded by landscaping to replicate entrance wall at other Noosa Waters entry

Timing and community impact

Work is scheduled to begin Monday, 17 June 2024 and completed by the end of July 2024, weather permitting. During this time, the park will be closed to the public.

Construction will take place from 7 AM to 5 PM, Monday through Friday. Increased noise levels are expected, particularly during the demolition phase from Monday, 17 June to Friday, 21 June.

Every effort will be made to minimise the impact on residents. Council appreciates your patience and understanding during the construction period.
