Upper Pinbarren Creek Road, Pinbarren

Noosa Council is pleased to advise Hazell Bros has been awarded the contract to undertake flood reconstruction on nine sites damaged on Upper Pinbarren Creek Road during the 2022 flood and rain event.

It is anticipated site establishment and construction will start at the end of June 2024 and take about five months to complete, weather and construction conditions permitting. One lane of traffic will be open to residents during construction, with traffic management details being finalised as a priority. In the meantime, you may see team members from Hazell Bros and Council undertaking inspections.

Further information about the changed traffic conditions and potential impacts for residents will be made available as soon as possible.


