# Pinbarren, Upper Pinbarren Creek Road

#### **Project update**

The 2022 flooding event caused damage at a number of locations on Upper Pinbarren Creek Road, Pinbarren.

Hazell Bros has started work to undertake flood reconstruction on nine sites from 376 to 516 Upper Pinbarren Creek Road.

Reconstruction will include:

- excavation and removal of unsuitable materials
- clearing and grubbing
- drainage works
- soil nails and grouting
- surface reconstruction
- barrier kerb works
- hydromulch and landscaping.

These works will help provide long-term stabilisation of the road.

The flood recovery effort for Noosa Council is jointly funded by the Commonwealth-State Disaster Recovery Funding Arrangements.

We acknowledge the significant disruption these works will cause residents and motorists.

Council would like to thank you for your ongoing patience while critical hinterland assets are repaired.

### **Construction timing**

Site establishment and construction started in early July 2024.

Construction will take until the end of the year, weather and construction conditions permitting.

# Traffic and community impacts

#### **Changed traffic conditions**

This section of Upper Pinbarren Creek Road will operate as a single lane under shuttle flow while construction is underway. Motorists will experience delays of up to 15 minutes.

The road will be open to one lane under temporary traffic signals outside work hours. Motorists are reminded to drive to the changed conditions and follow signage and any directions from traffic controllers.

#### Work hours

Construction will generally be completed between Monday and Saturday, 6.30am-6.30pm.

#### Audible noise and vibration

Audible noise and vibration from construction activities can be expected. Reversing beepers and flashing lights are a safety requirement on heavy machinery and will be used during work hours.
