### Noosaville, Mary Street – Road Island Tree Works

#### **Project summary**

Contractors will soon commence road island tree works on Mary Street, Noosaville.

The road islands are predominately planted with Jagera pseudorphus, or foam bark trees. Some of these trees have struggled since they were planted, and many are now in decline. Council is planning to remove the dying trees, rejuvenate the soil and replant with appropriate species.

#### Scope of work

- 10 declining Foam barks will be removed and stump ground.
- Some understory plants will be removed.
- The soil will be treated to some nutrients and rejuvenation and then left to rest for a short time.
- The gardens beds will be planted out with new species, proven to work in the local conditions, aligning with future predicted climate models.

#### **Duration of work**

Tree removal work is scheduled to commence 15<sup>th</sup> August with the garden bed rejuvenation taking place towards the end of the month.

Replanting of the road islands will occur in September, subject to weather and construction conditions.

# Disruptions to traffic and the public

Every effort will be made to minimise the impact on traffic, however delays of up to 10 minutes can be expected.

The work will be undertaken during the day between 6.30am and 6.30pm with traffic control in place and the closure of one lane will be required. All traffic will be diverted around the work site using the shoulder of the road as a temporary lane.

Your patience during this project is appreciated.

#### Further information

As per Council's Tree Management on Public Land policy, where possible, suitable replacements will be planted with an extended maintenance period.
