Cooroy-Belli Creek Road, Black Mountain

The 2022 flooding event caused damage at several locations on Cooroy-Belli Creek Road.

Noosa Council is pleased to advised work has been completed on the section adjacent to 673 and 705 Cooroy-Belli Creek Road. This follows the recent completion of work near 490 Cooroy-Belli Creek Road, Cooroy.

We acknowledge the significant disruptions along Cooroy-Belli Creek Road arising from recent bridge renewal and these stormwaters repairs. Thank you for your ongoing patience while Council maintains and repairs critical hinterland assets.

Reconstruction to provide long-term stability of the road included:

- excavation and removal of unsuitable materials
- 126 piles (600mm diameter and 9m deep) and soil anchors 12m long to provide long-term stability
- constructing a retaining wall 150m long and 1.5 high, which was tied to the piles to withstand future slides
- drainage works
- rock scour protection, with 650m³ placed
- pavement reconstruction and sealing
- installing guardrail.

The flood recovery effort for Noosa Council is jointly funded by the Commonwealth-State Disaster Recovery Funding Arrangements.
