
Apex Park Fitness Equipment Renewal Project Noosaville Foreshore

Project summary

The four fitness stations in Apex Park on the Noosaville foreshore, last updated in 2010, need replacement due to environmental wear and the removal of some equipment, which has rendered parts unusable.

This project is part of the Council's annual infrastructure renewal program and is independent from the Noosaville Foreshore Infrastructure Master Plan, which is still in review.

Council is committed to ongoing maintenance and necessary refurbishment to ensure the foreshore is maintained to a good standard.

Design

Community consultation conducted in October 2023 and feedback from fitness professionals has helped shape the design for the new equipment.

Key recommendations included:

- user-friendly equipment.
- emphasise bodyweight exercises.
- suitable for various ages and fitness levels.
- wheelchair accessible
- clear usage instructions
- ease of maintenance with few moving parts and no hydraulics.

Timing and community impact

Installation of the four fitness stations is scheduled to **begin Monday, 30 September 2024** and take approximately a month to complete, weather permitting.

During this period, the fitness stations will be closed, and safety barriers will be installed to restrict access.

Access to the foreshore, playground, and amenities will remain open as usual.
