Project summary

Council has been upgrading pathways in Tewantin and Noosaville to enhance community connectivity.

Additionally, two crucial missing pathway links in Tewantin and Cooroy have been completed as part of the Council's Missing Links initiative, which aims to meet the community's increasing demand for new and improved pathways throughout the region.

These works align with the Council's Cycling and Walking Strategy, aimed at improving the safety and well-being of pedestrians and cyclists throughout the shire.

The following pathways are now completed:

- Cooroy Noosa Rd, Tewantin
- Griffith Ave, Tewantin
- Kauri St, Cooroy

- Quota Park, Noosaville


Completion time: approximately 1 week (weather permitting)

Griffith Ave, Tewantin (Between Cedarleigh Dr. and Harlow Cres)	October	Implementation of a 2m wide concrete pathway missing link, and bus stop.	
Kauri St, Cooroy (Between the corner of Kauri St./Topaz St. and Ruby St.)	October	Implementation of a 1.5m and 2m wide concrete pathway missing link.	 <p data-bbox="683 1037 1474 1133">This is part of a long planned pathway upgrade to service existing needs of residents on an important walking route for local residents.</p>
