Noosa Heads, Main Beach & Little Cove Beach – Gross Pollution Trap & Noxious Weeds Works

Project summary

Council will soon commence clearance works at the gross pollution traps at Little Cove Beach, along with the removal of noxious vegetation.

To facilitate the removal of noxious weeds, a Posi-track will be required to travel between Noosa Main Beach and Little Cove Beach, with works scheduled around tide conditions.

Duration of work

Work is scheduled to commence on 27th February 2025 with completion expected the same day, subject to weather and tide conditions.

The work will be undertaken during the day between the hours of 6.30am and 6.30pm.

Disruptions to traffic and the public

Every effort will be made to minimise the impact on traffic and pedestrians, however delays of up to 10 minutes can be expected.

The work will be undertaken between 1.00pm and 5.00pm with traffic control in place. Four car spaces at First Point Carpark will be temporarily closed.

Residents are asked not to park in this area during these times. Vehicles parked in the work area will be towed.
