

Goodchap Street Stormwater Upgrade, Noosaville

Project summary

Noosa Council is undertaking essential stormwater upgrade works on Goodchap Street in Noosaville. These works aim to improve stormwater management along the street, addressing long-standing drainage concerns and enhancing the resilience of local infrastructure.

Scope of works

This project includes the construction of new stormwater infrastructure to enhance drainage and manage runoff. Key works include:

- Installing new stormwater inlet gullies.
- Constructing a 600mm diameter stormwater pipe from the Juro and Goodchap Street intersection to the existing system at 74 Goodchap Street.
- Building a new stormwater inlet structure and extending the kerb on the northern side of Goodchap Street.

These upgrades will assist in managing stormwater more effectively and mitigating flooding risks in the area.

Duration of work

Work is scheduled to **commence by the end of March and completed by mid-June 2025**, subject to weather and construction conditions.

The work will be completed during the day between the hours of 6:30am and 6:30pm.

Community impacts

Both lanes of traffic will remain open throughout the project, with traffic control measures in place to ensure public safety.

Some construction noise is expected during working hours, and efforts will be made to minimise disruptions.

We appreciate residents' patience and cooperation as we undertake these essential upgrades.
