

Peregian Square Maintenance & Minor Refurbishment, Peregian Beach

Project Summary

Maintenance and minor refurbishment work is underway at the Peregian Square Precinct to enhance safety, accessibility, and overall upkeep. This includes refreshing garden beds and lawns, trimming overhanging branches, and stormwater management. These efforts will help preserve green spaces, improve connectivity between the park and dining precinct, and ensure the area remains an enjoyable community hub.

Scope of Works

Key deliverables of the project include:

- Refurbishment of garden beds and lawn
- Additional seating
- Tree trimming
- Activity platform renewal
- Stormwater management

Timing

Construction is scheduled to **commence late April 2025** (after the school holidays) and take approximately six weeks to complete, subject to weather and construction conditions.

Work Hours

Construction will take place from Monday to Friday, between 6:30 AM and 5:00 PM.

Community Impacts

During construction, some sections of the square may be temporarily closed. While noise, dust and minor disruptions are expected, efforts will be made to minimise inconvenience.

Alternative pedestrian pathways will be provided as needed, ensuring continued accessibility.
